

Our environmental statement

At the Barrière de Transinne, we are fully aware of the limited resources of our planet and the impact of our sector on the environment. Our hotel wants to meet current needs without compromising the needs of future generations.

That's why we have decided to implement an environmental policy that allows us to reduce our ecological footprint while maintaining a quality service.

Due to its know-how the Barrière de Transinne crossed the decades and the approaches. Nowadays the ecological future of our planet is envolved and we have decided to contribute to the preservation of the environment thanks to the Green Key label.

The Green Key is an international eco-label awarded to tourism establishments for their environmental initiatives.

In this context, the Barrière de Transinne commits itself

- to provide the necessary human resources for the accomplishment of its environmental management system ;
- to integrate the protection and the preservation of the environment into the daily management of its activities, aiming for a continuous improvement ;
- to comply with the environmental legislation applicable to its activities ;
- to decrease the environmental impacts of its activities.

Our general investments to reduce our ecological footprint

- A treatment plant
- In the offices, the employees and collaborators of the Barrière de Transinne are made aware of this sustainable consumption. Only what's necessary is printed.
- Recycling bins are present in the areas dedicated to the staff. All waste is sorted : cardboard, organic waste and glass.
- Dual flush toilets are installed.
- Collaborations with environmentally friendly suppliers are in place.
- The lighting is managed by domotics and LED light bulbs with low energy consumption have been installed in all the rooms.

Regarding the hotel

- Each of our 27 rooms are equipped with double glazed windows and the card readers turn off the lights automatically when the guest leaves the room.
- The televisions are energy efficient flat screens
- Motion detectors in the halls are installed in order to not leave the light on continuously.
- Floor insulation, thermal and sound insulation are present throughout the establishment.
- The outside lighting is turned off automatically at dawn.
- In winter, the heating is switched on at 3 pm in the occupied rooms only in order to reduce fuel consumption.
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The Wellness, sauna and hammam are only working on request

- The Wellness will only be turned on when booked and turned off when the guests' session ends.

At the restaurant

- Most of our vegetables are local and organic.
- We only use cloth napkins, tablecloths and cloth placemats to limit the paper waste.
- The menu card is restricted to avoid waste and a menu is proposed according to the market and the season.
- We work with local producers to limit the ecological impact and to encourage the economy of the region.

In our conference rooms

- The lights and the audio-visual material are switched on just before the arrival of the guests.

To act, to inform, to train and to encourage are the keywords for the success of the Barrière de Transinne. That's why the hotel also involves the guests through the « Go Green » program : the guest is encouraged to reduce the environmental impact of his stay through easy and convivial actions ;
